"I love being on Colleton County girls varsity basketball team because we are all close like sisters," senior Christian Williams said.

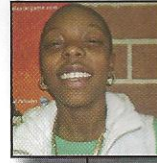
"I love playing basketball, but it is a lot of work" sophomore Loretha Chaney said.



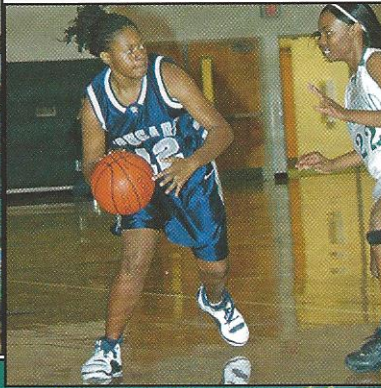
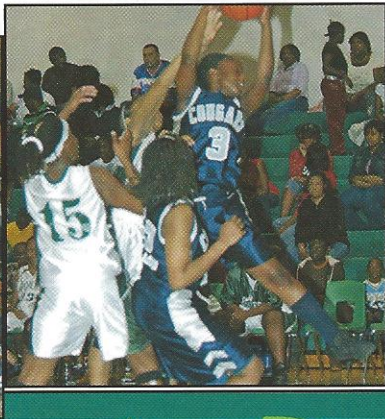
"I had a lot of fun going to Miami, Florida to play in the tournaments with other top teams," senior Brittany Reed said.
