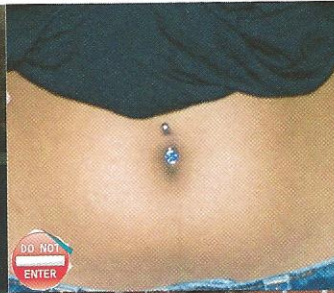


"I like tattoos but I think too much is tacky."
