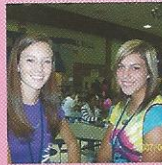




"We were going to Northside Elementary, a car was pulling out of nowhere, and suddenly we were hit." freshman Katiyyn Adams said.



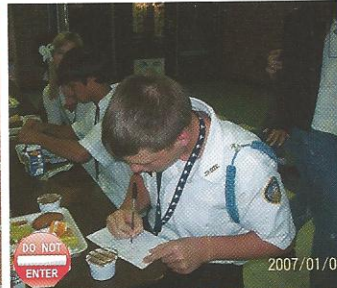
"I was in a small accident, we were hit by the people behind us. Lesson learned-pay attention." sophomore Katalin Ritter said.

Shareece Rivers stopped in the commons area to talk about her car wreck. "I was in a car wreck and broke my arm." junior Shareece Rivers said.

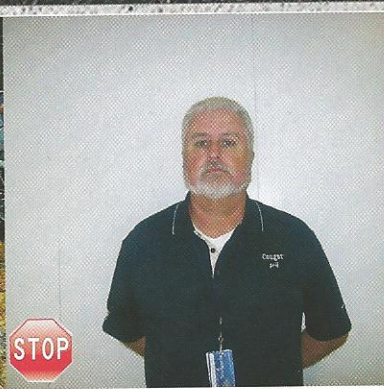
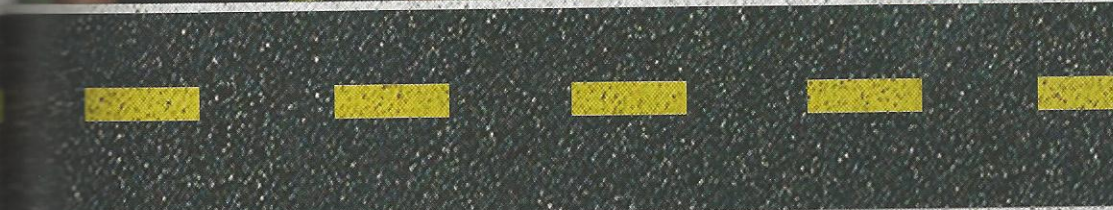
