Former senior Amber Hilburn was on her way to the restroom when she stopped for a picture. "I think prom could be in a better place, besides in the school gym," Amber said.



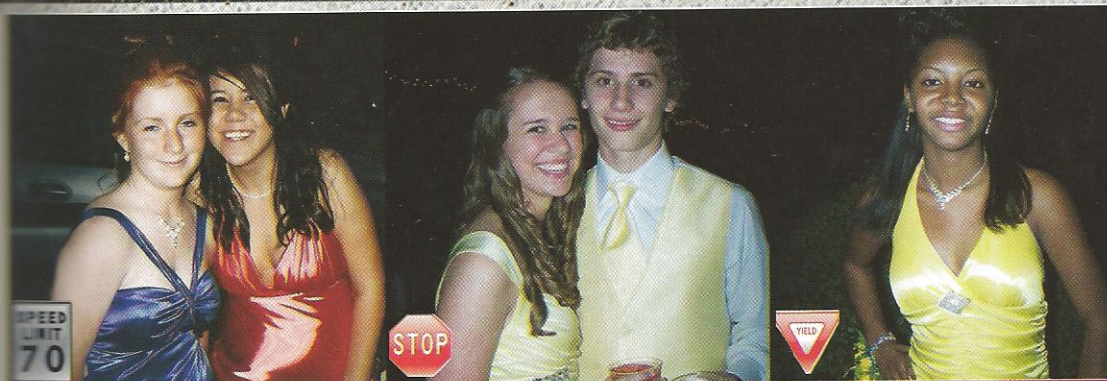

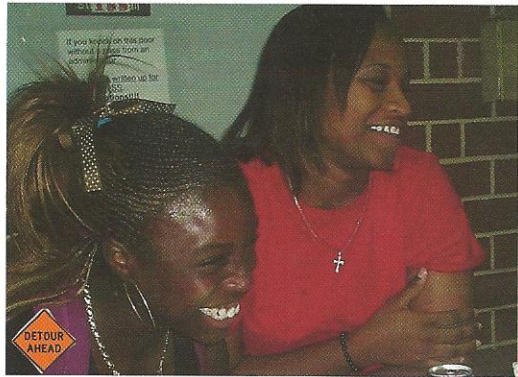


Express Yourself

many different reasons that ranged from family members names to their favorite bands. Tattoos and piercings expressed our individuality and personal lifestyles.

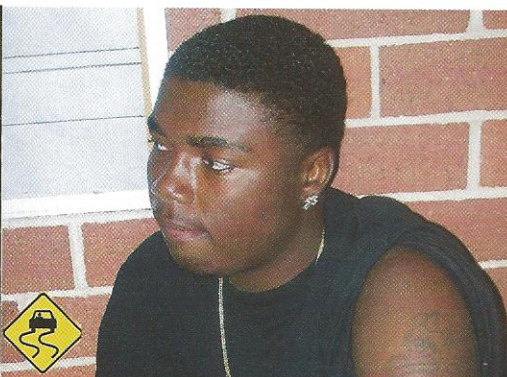

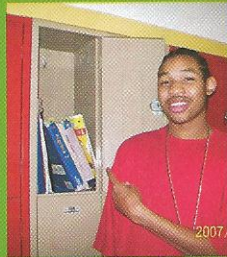
"Sporty"

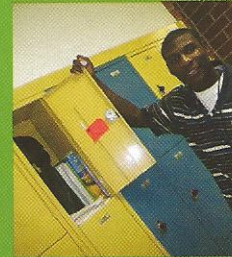
Jamore Moultrie was thinking his locker would pass as sporty one day after school. "I keep all my books inside of my locker," junior Jamore said.

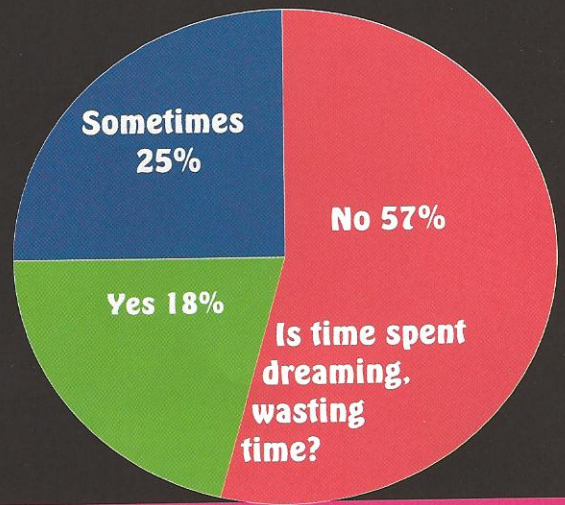


After cracking some jokes on a friend, senior Ryan McGhie explains that he loves his job. "I work for Prestige Worldwide!" Ryan said.

helps students achieve in life and most of the classes prepare you for your future, and help you get a jump start on learning about what you need to know for your future career.



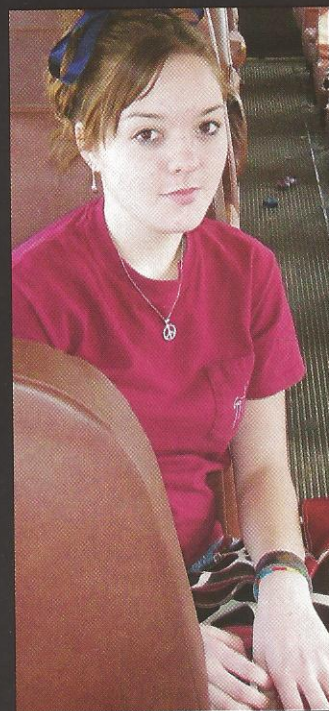
