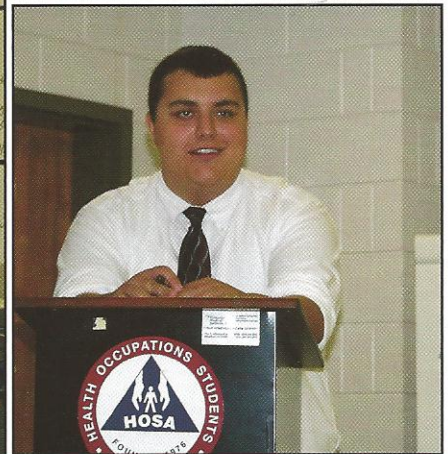

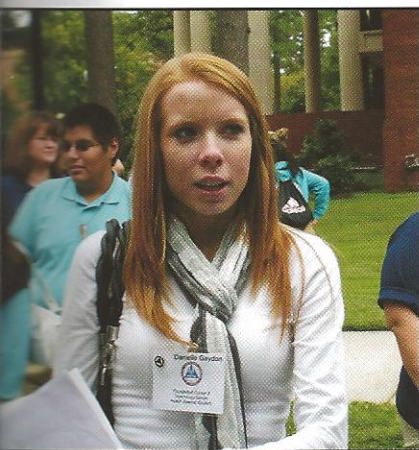
IN the Hands that Achieve!
