"I was in Ms. Bozard's class," said Veronica Bastian.

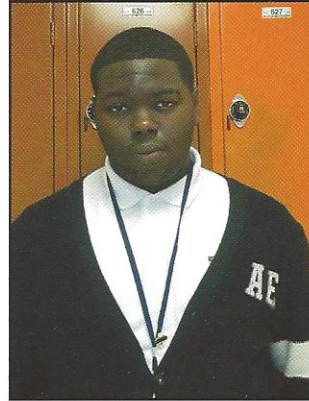

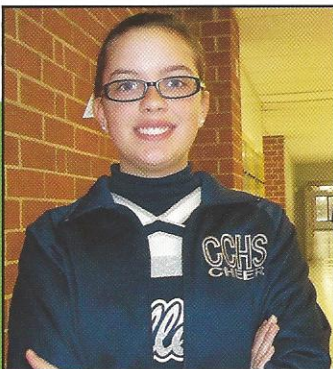
