

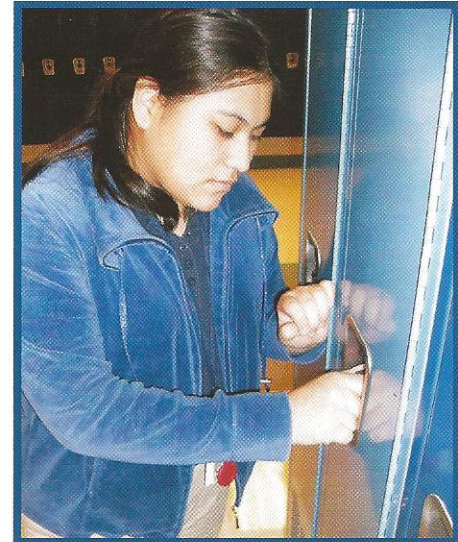
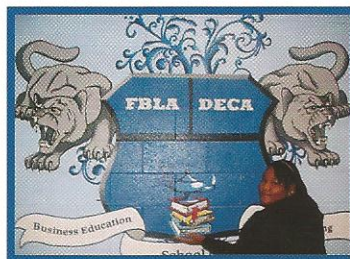
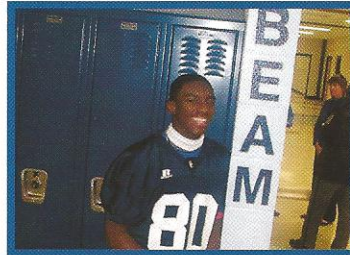


# BEAM

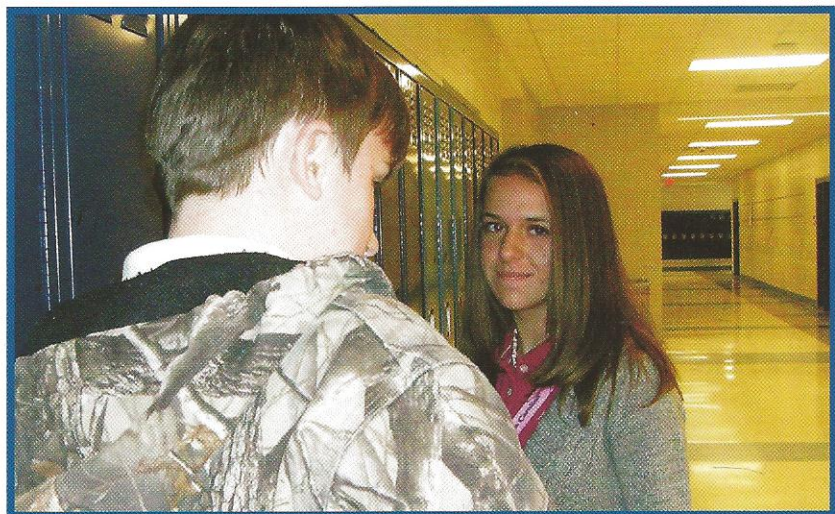
