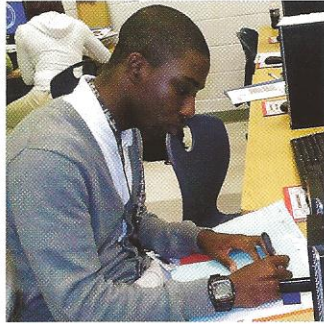

Senior Anthony Taylor said, "I believe yearbook brings out true leadership and dedication and helps you succeed." He encouraged himself to be in yearbook.



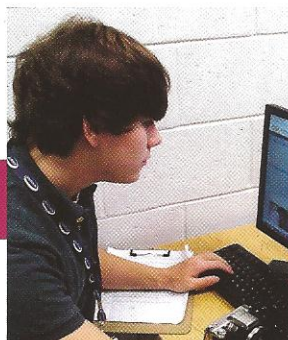
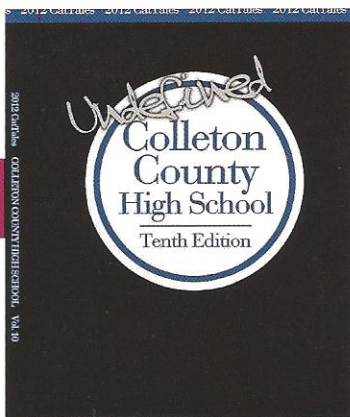

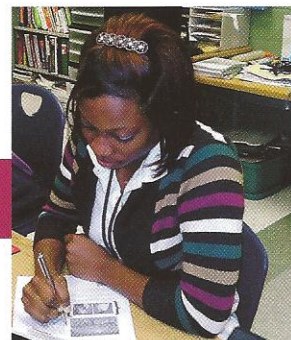
