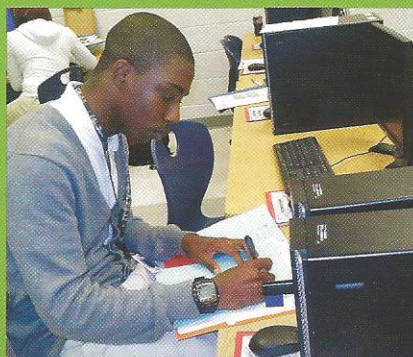
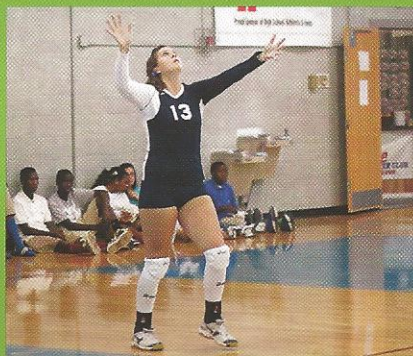


Above The members of student council collected gifts for a non-profit organization called Toys for Tots. This organization provides new unwrapped gifts for the less fortunate children in the community.

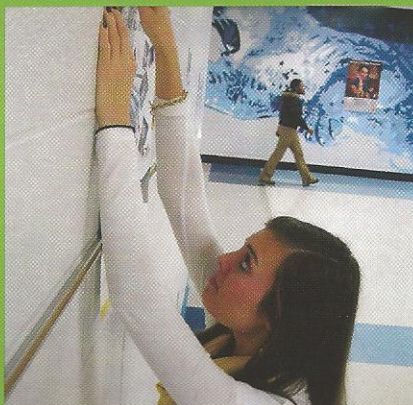
From left to right are sophomore officers: President Hannah Houck, Vice-President Donald Rizer, and Secretary Caitlin James.
