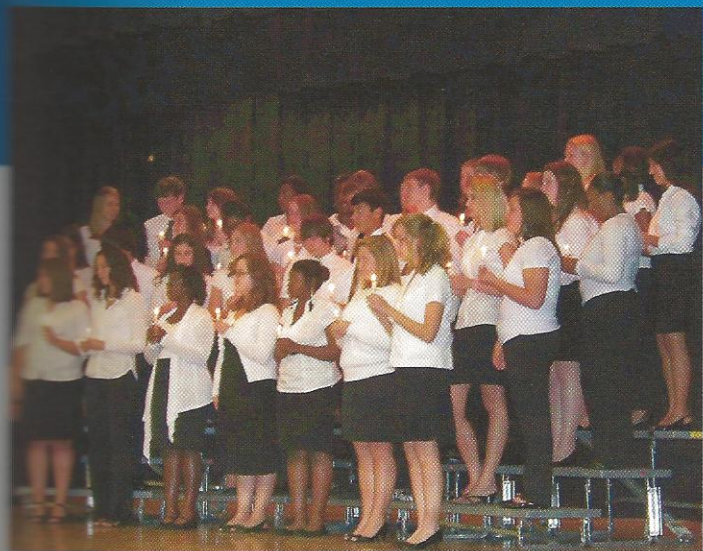


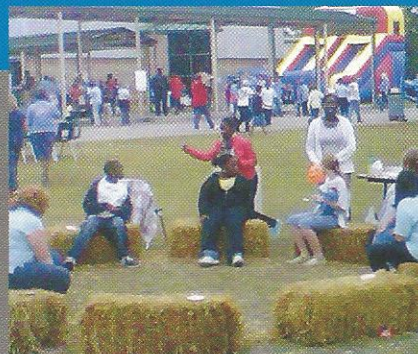
## What is the best part of being in the National Honor Society?
