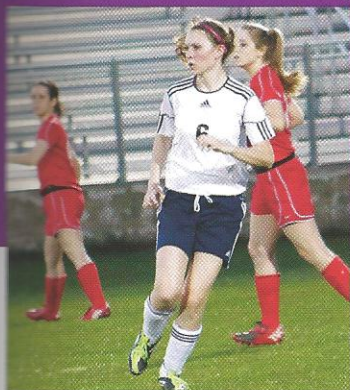


What is your favorite soccer memory?

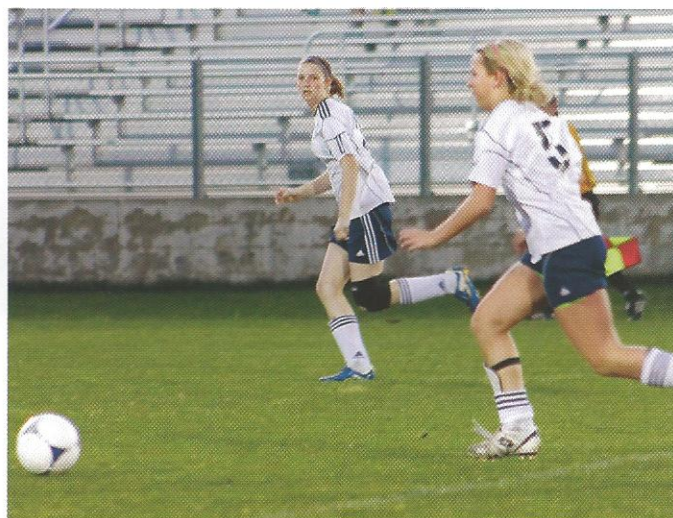
Junior Jenny Beebe
