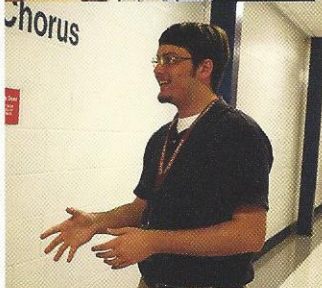
"I joined the FBLA so I would be able to learn more about the business field and to meet new people."
