
"HOSA is important to me because it gives me more options to help choose my occupation. We also raise money for all types of cancer and cystic fibrosis."

"HOSA's important to me because I'm pursuing a career in the health field, and it is an organization that is made for students that are pursuing a health care profession and introduces leadership."


