



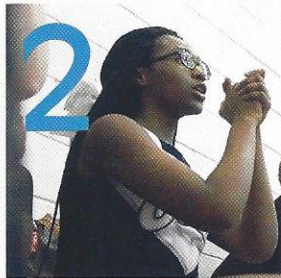

The Junior Varsity cheerleaders have accomplished many things this season.

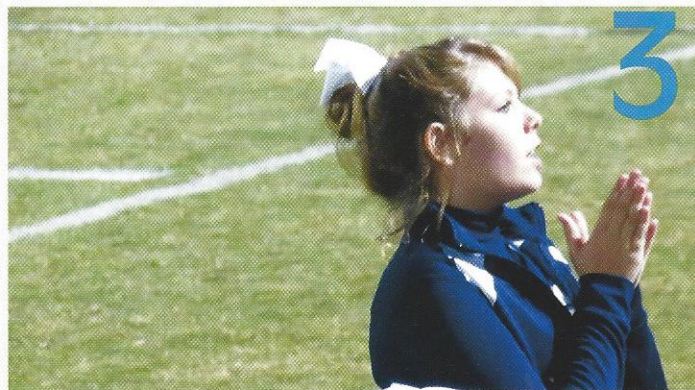
