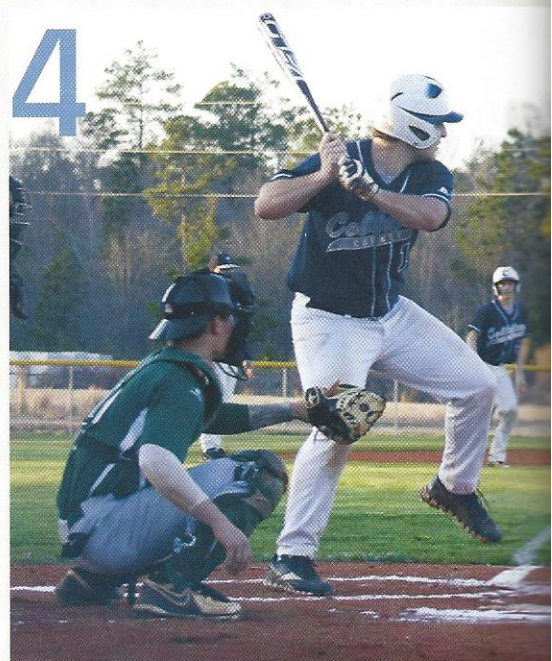
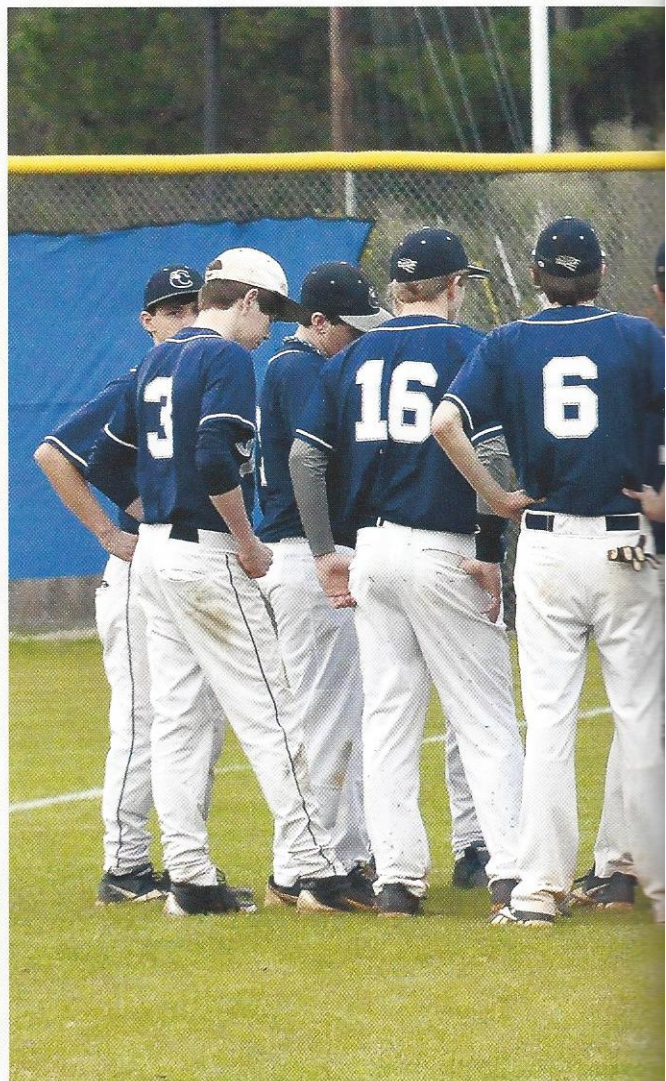




"Baseball is important to me because when I cross the chalk and step onto the field, nothing else matters or exists in my mind except for the ball and the opponent I must defeat."
