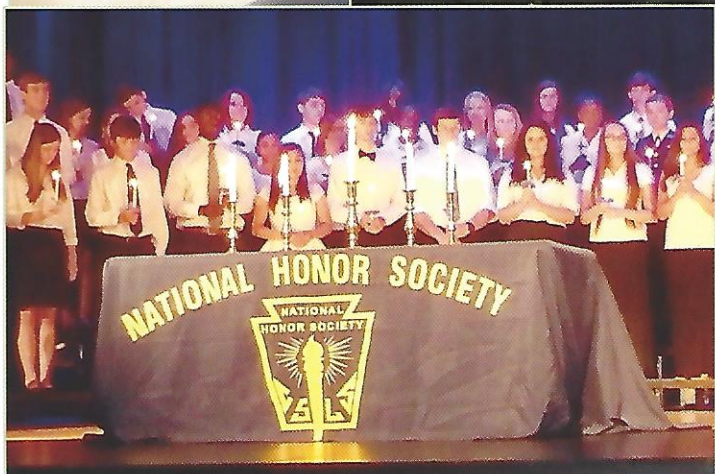
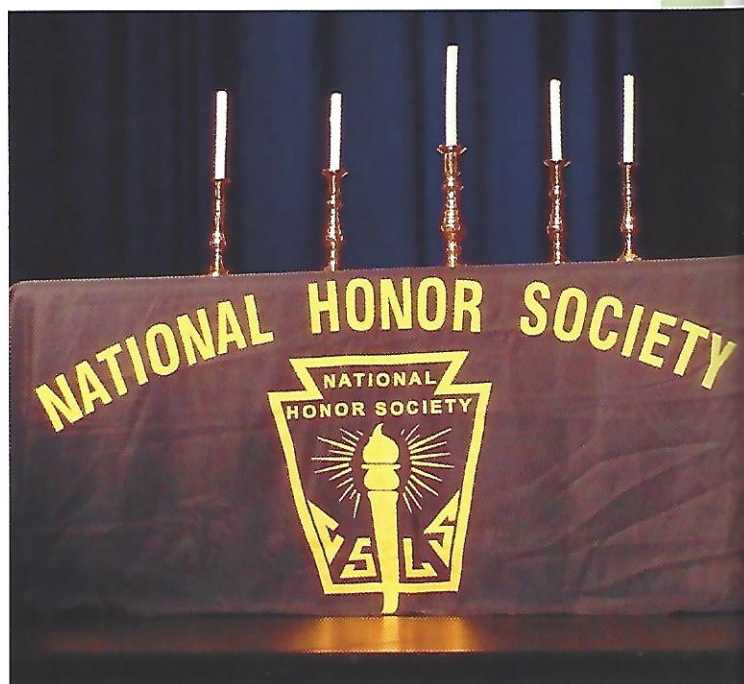


NHS
