

Boys Varsity Basketball

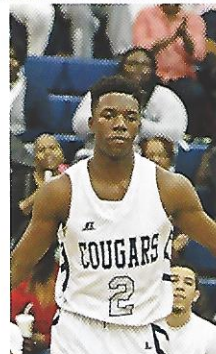
