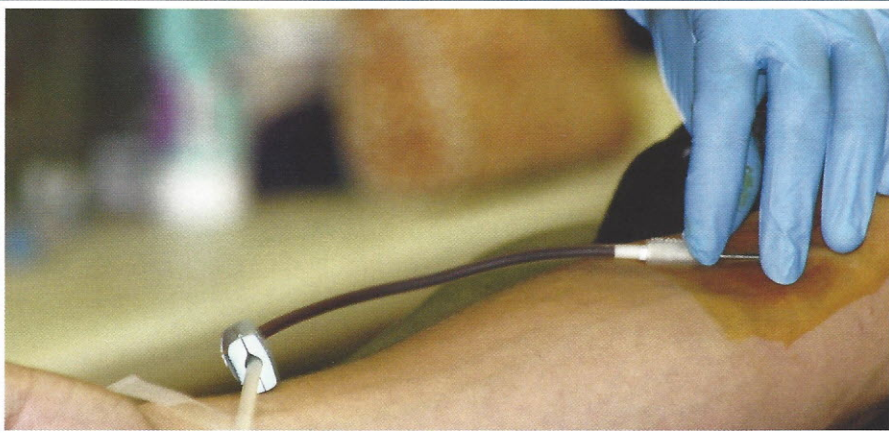


# RED CROSS
