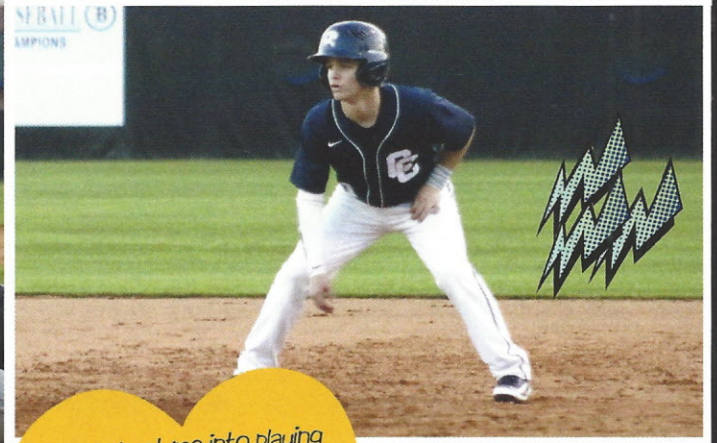


1. The team huddles in a group with their coach to discuss their next big game plan.
