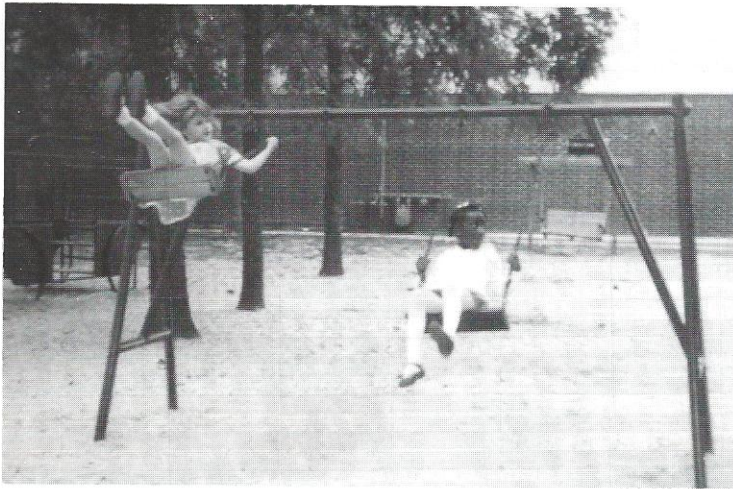


Kindergarten
