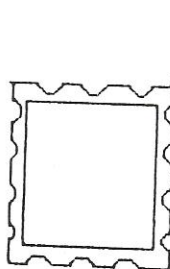




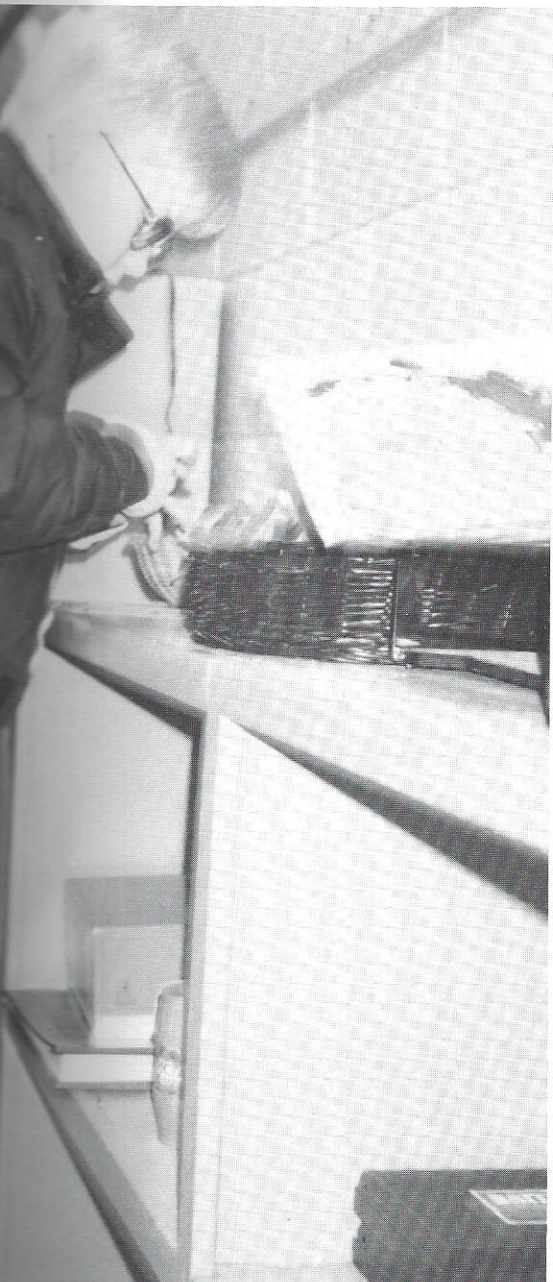
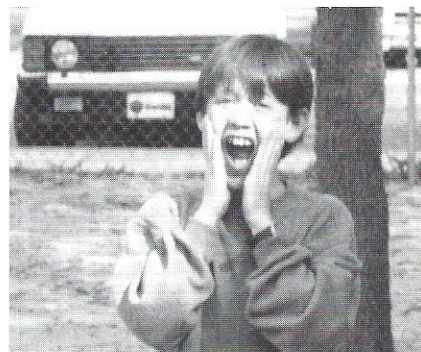
Michael Upchurch talks to some of his younger friends during a Thanksgiving feast in which the lower school participated.
