

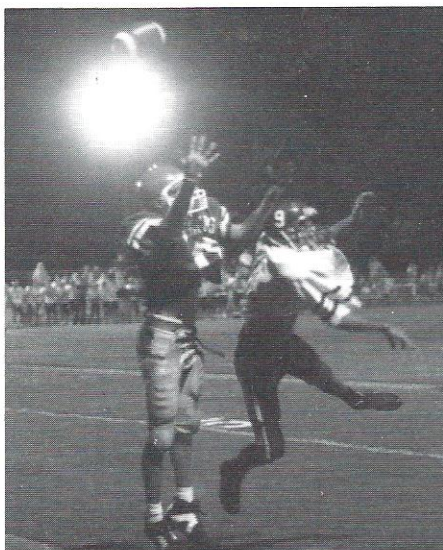
Varsity Football

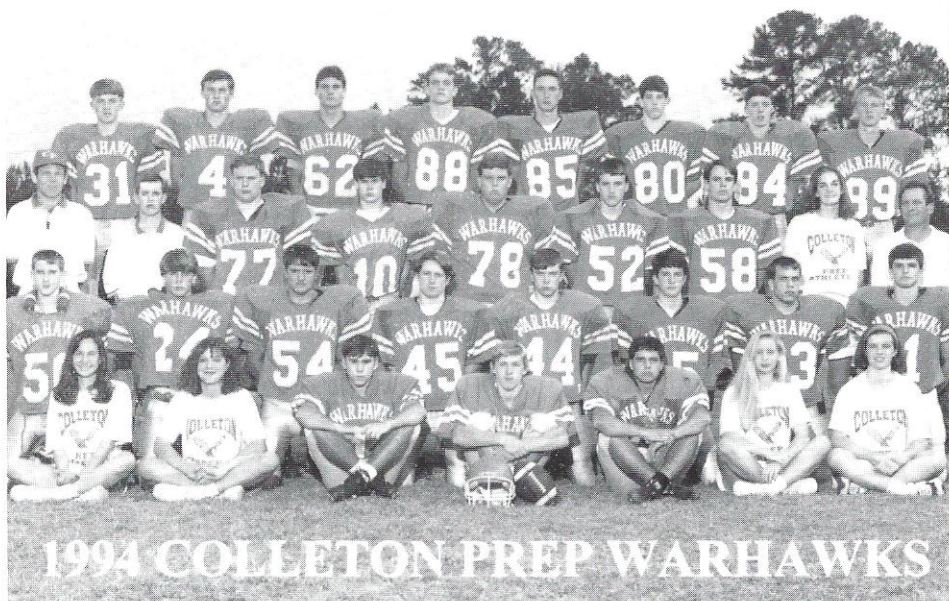
Wes Pye, Perry Hunt, and Daniel Garris, were chosen to play on the Senior North-South All-Star team.
