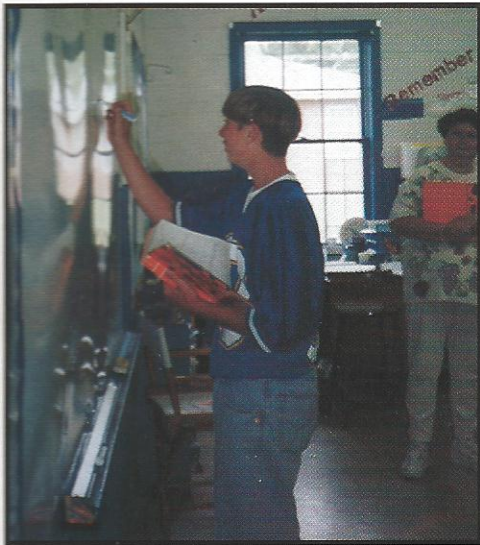


Remember the Time
