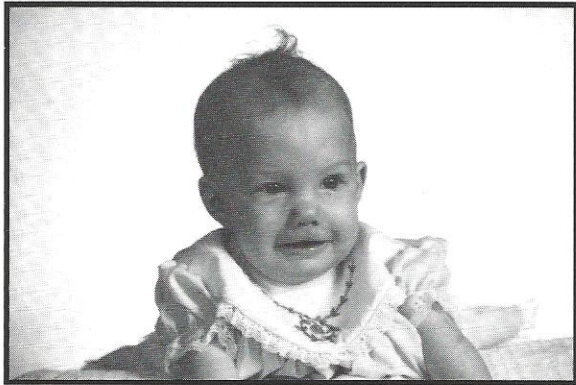


Dear Jennifer,

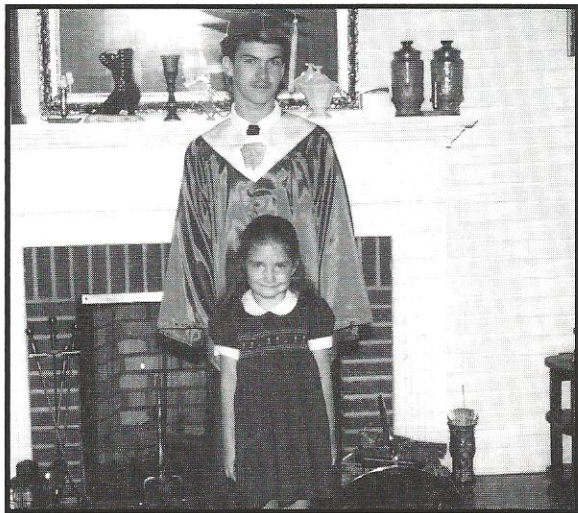
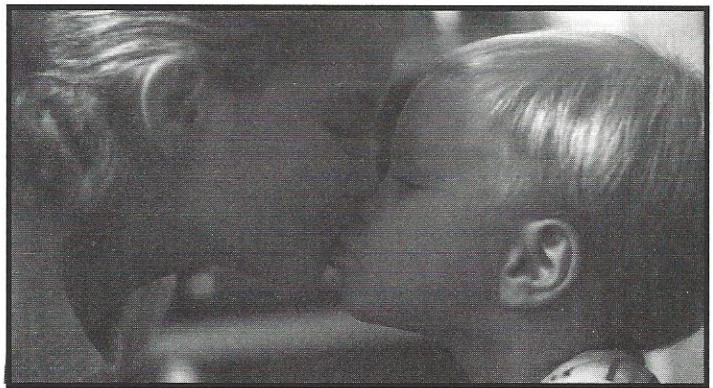
