Thank you, Mrs. Copeland, you have enriched our lives by contributing so much to the CPA family.



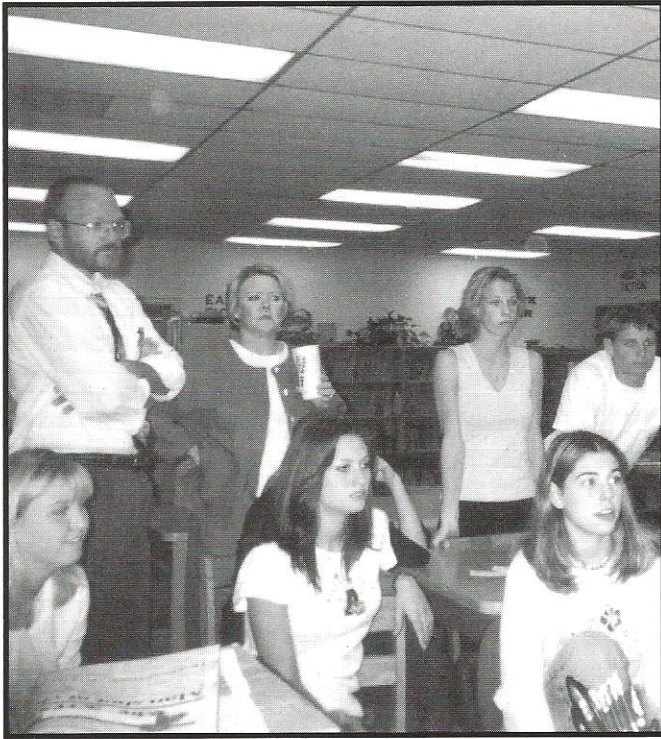

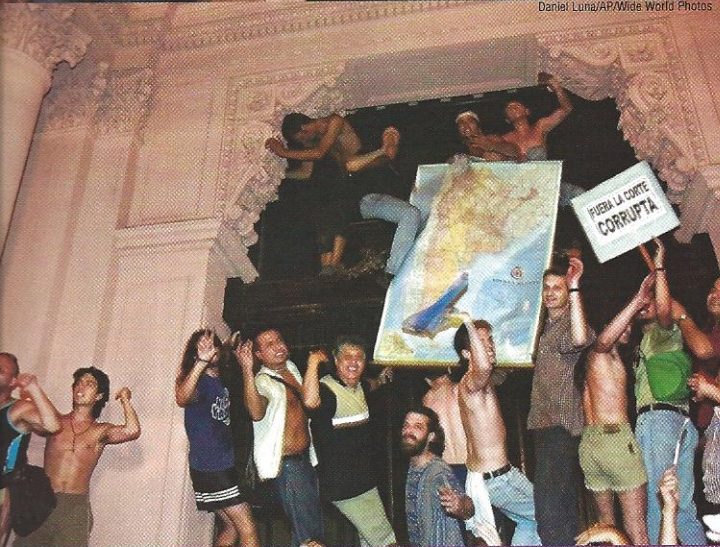

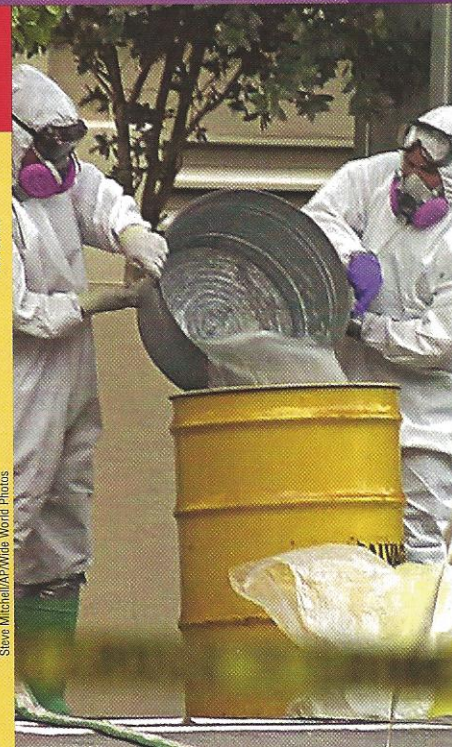

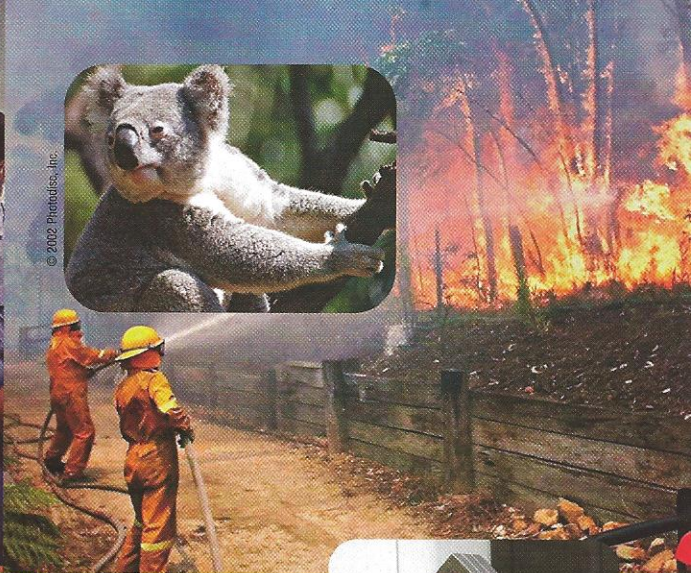

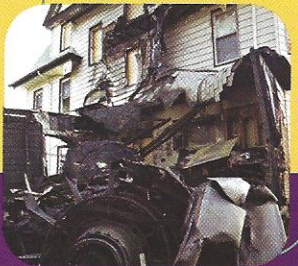

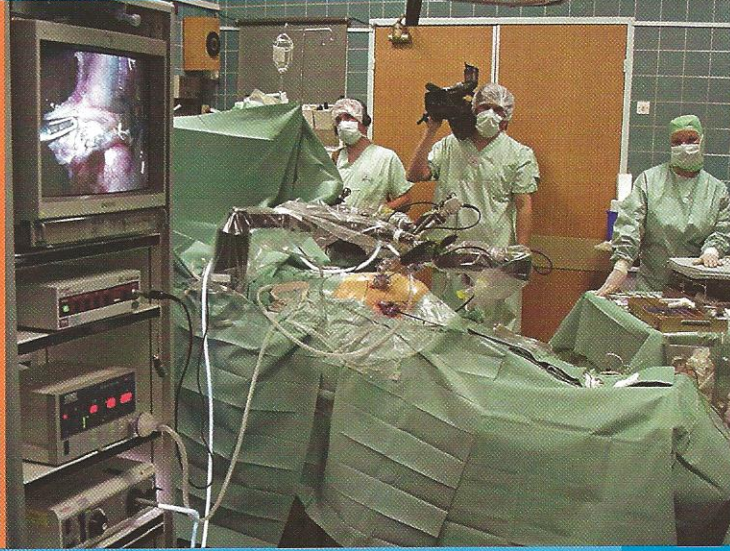

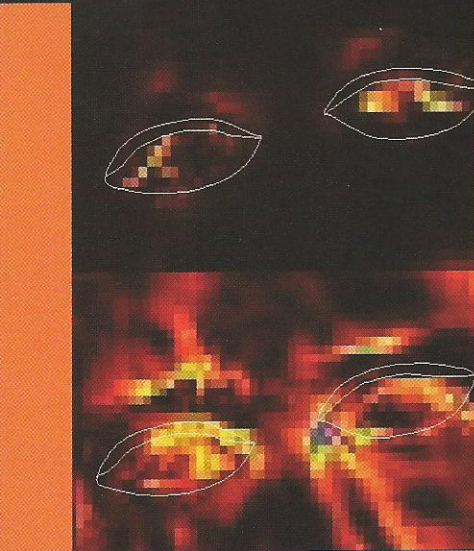

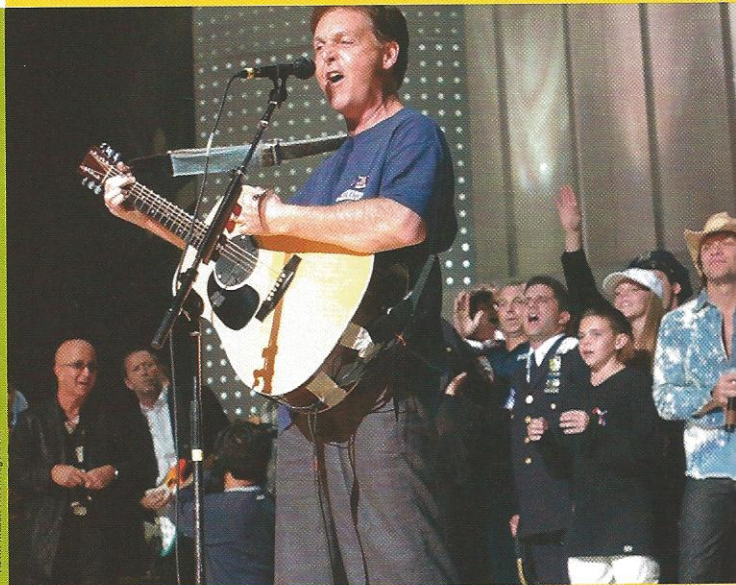

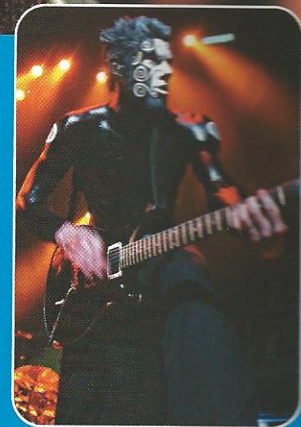

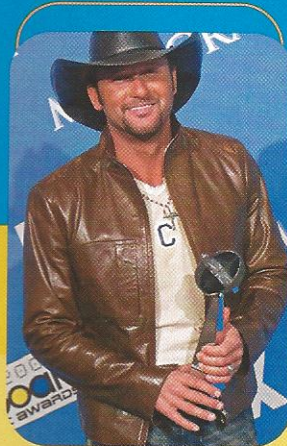

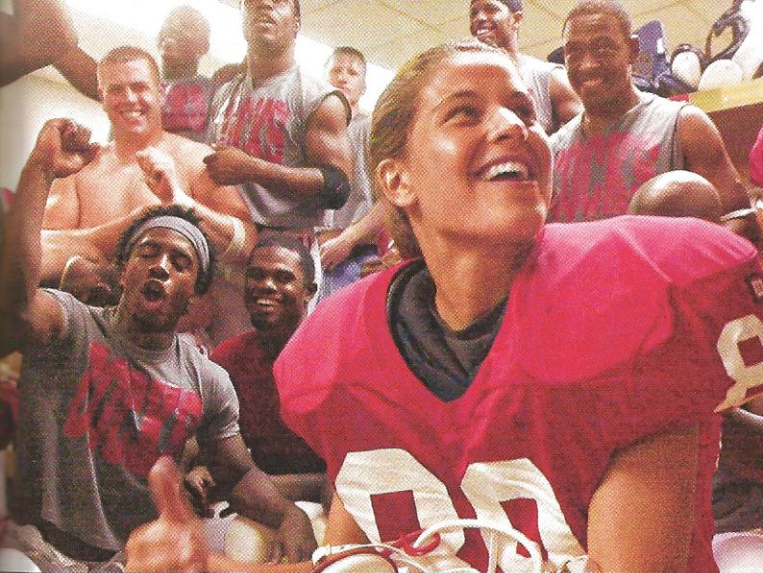
