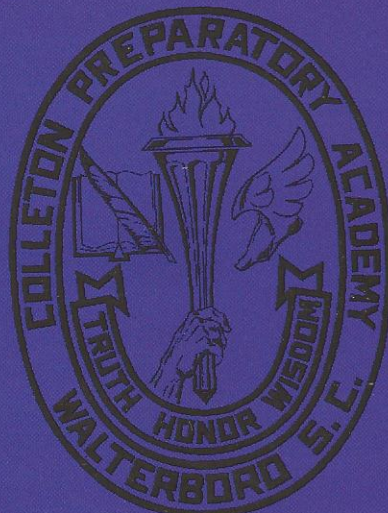

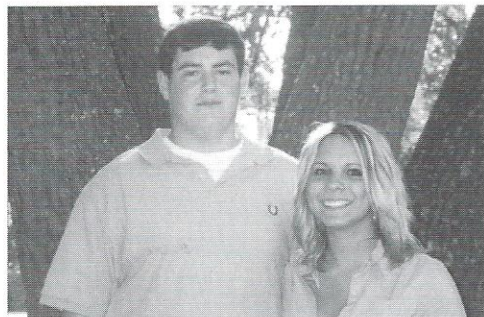

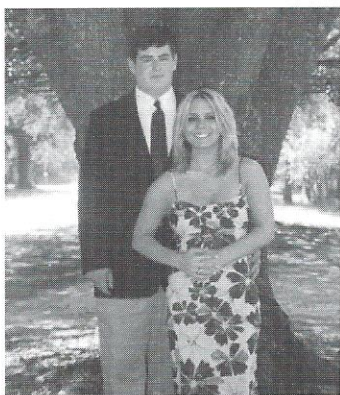
## Mr. & Ms. Talon 2005



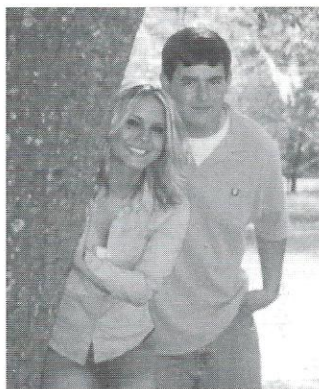

The student body participates in a variety of activities during this week to support the football team. This year, our spirit week consisted of pajama day, college day, camo day, and blue and white day.



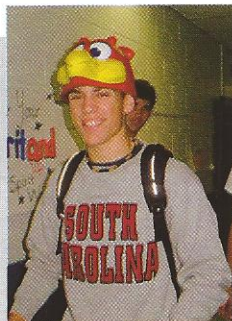

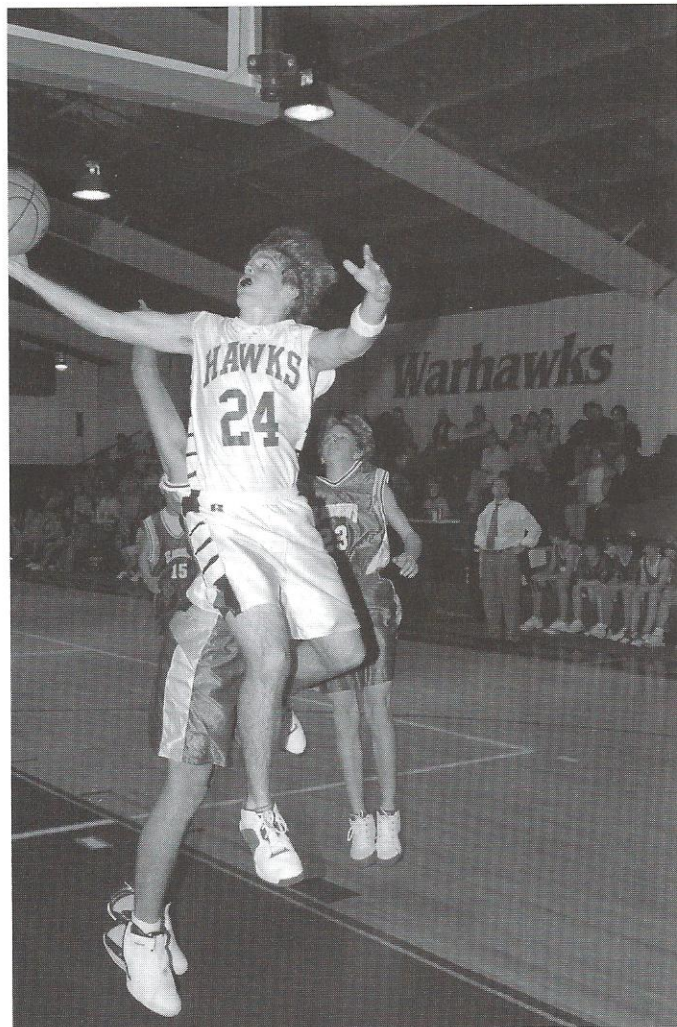

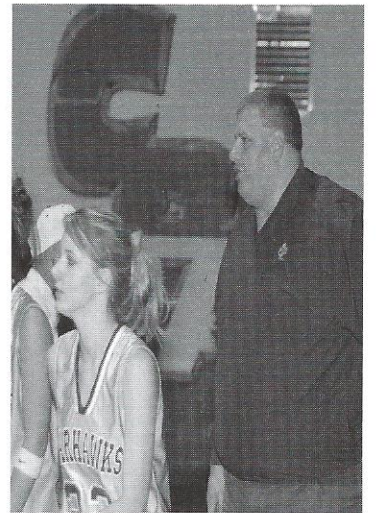
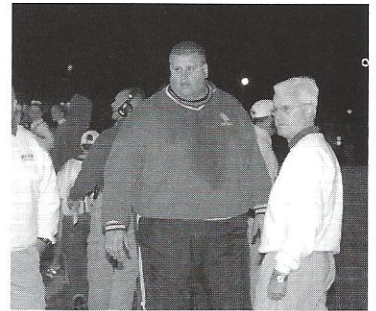
## Coach Miller,

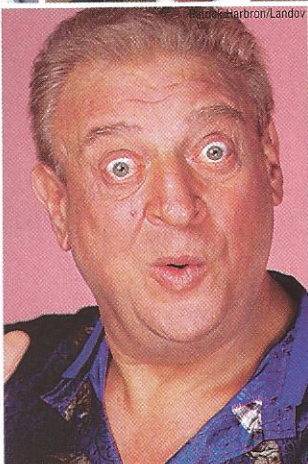
