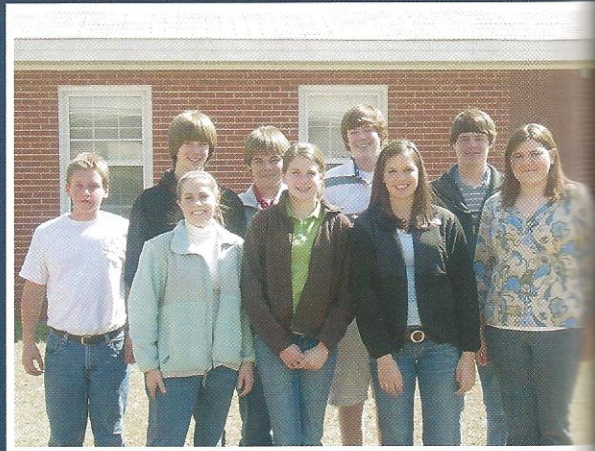


President's Award for Educational Excellence
