R. O. T. C. Camp. Every man has several regular class periods during the week devoted to instructions in military science and tactics, a study of weapons and military procedure, and problems that confront the military officer. There are three hours each week on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday afternoons devoted to drill and field work.

On the field the cadets are taught the fundamentals of military drill and discipline. They have days set aside for parades, inspection, calisthenics, and extended order in the field. There is also one day in the late spring which is devoted to an inspection and rating by visiting officers; and a day for competitive drill between companys, platoons, squads. and individuals.
