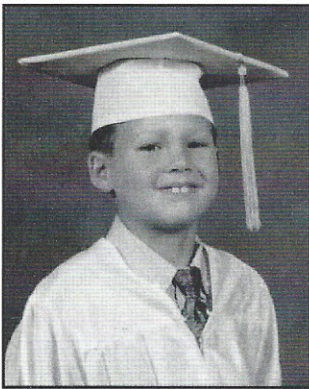
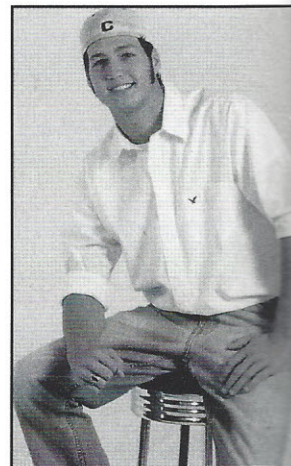
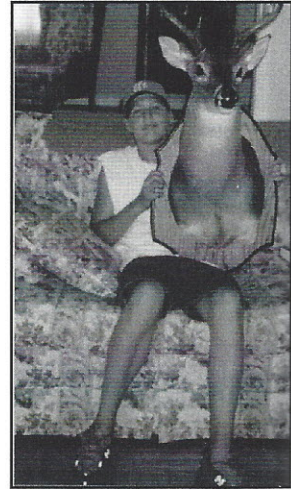


JAMES KIZER
