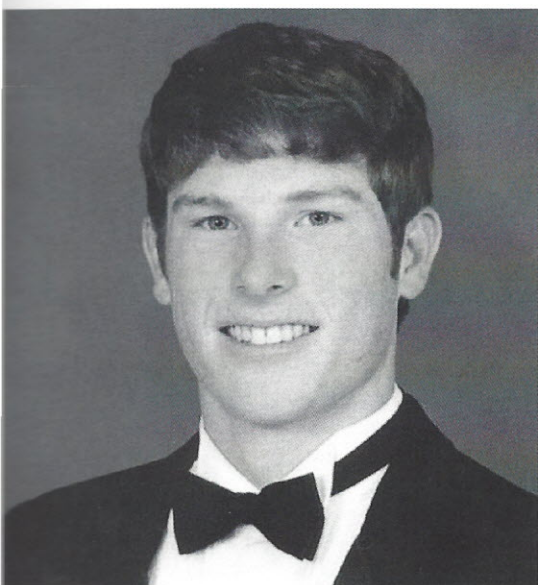
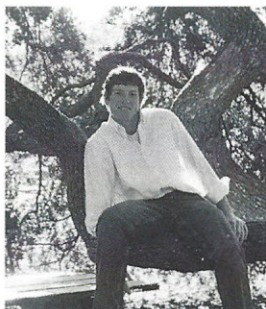


Dustin:
