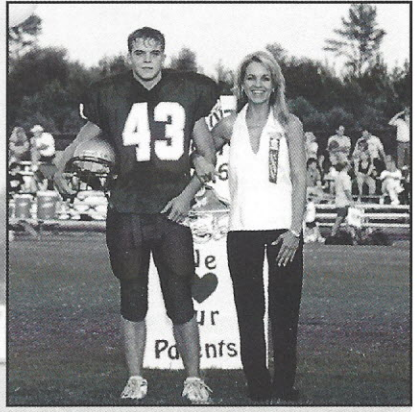


Cody
