The PTO plans to continue its many projects to keep the school up-to-date and well organized.

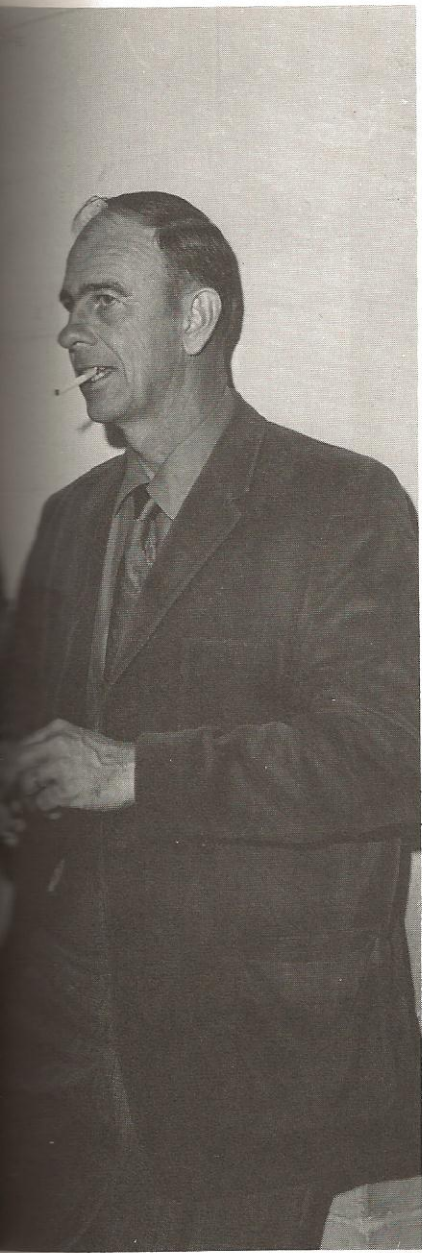
