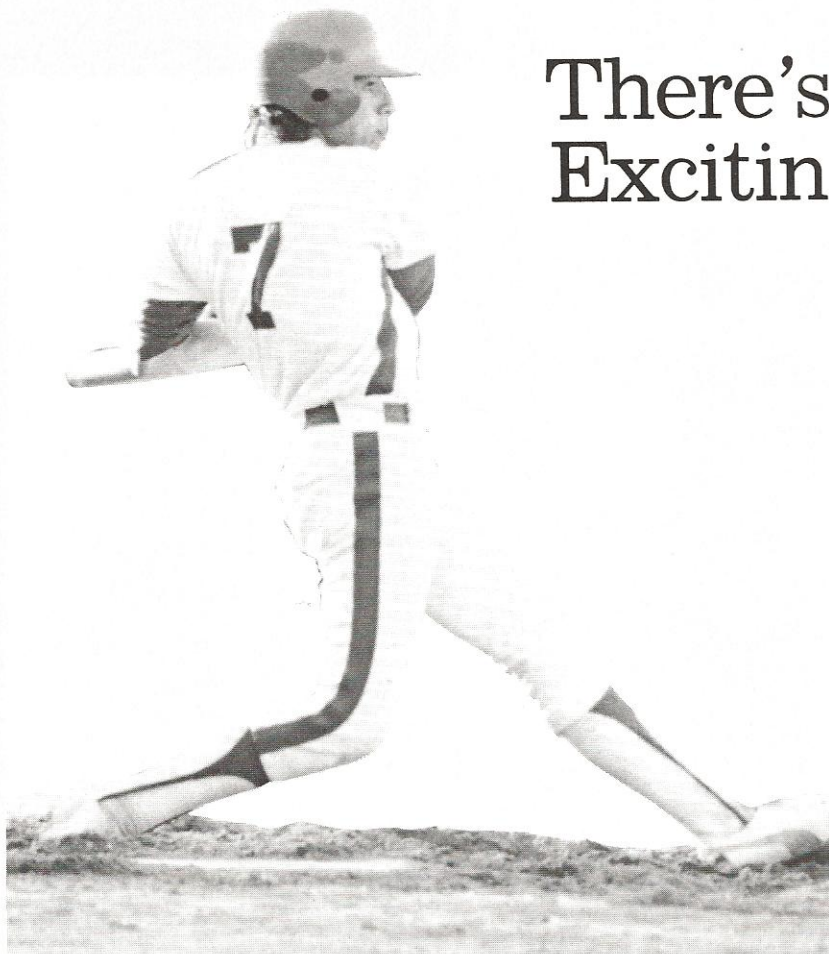


There's Something Exciting Going On
