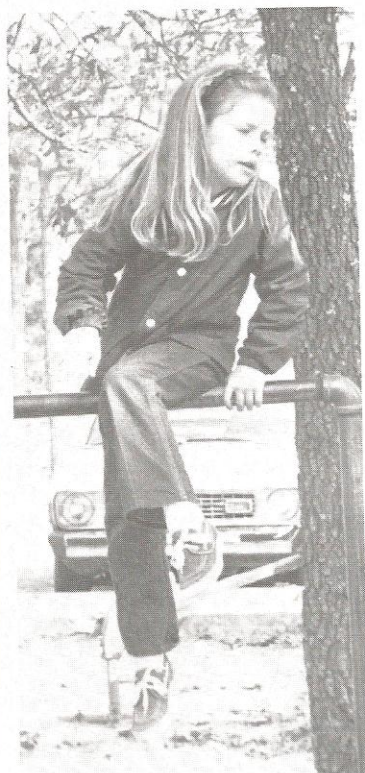


The Three Components Of J.C.C.A.
