



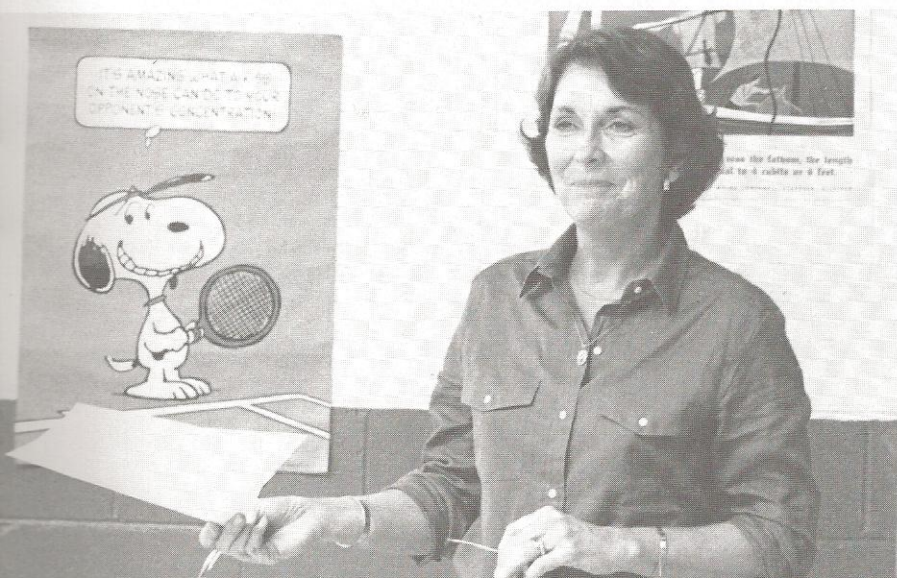
Math Improves Reasoning Skills
