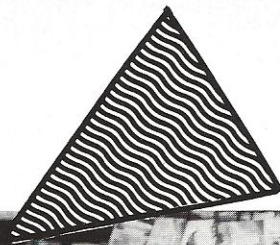


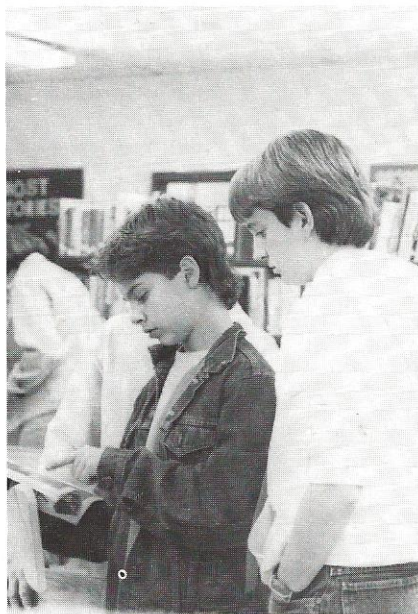
The Library Is A "Happening Place"
