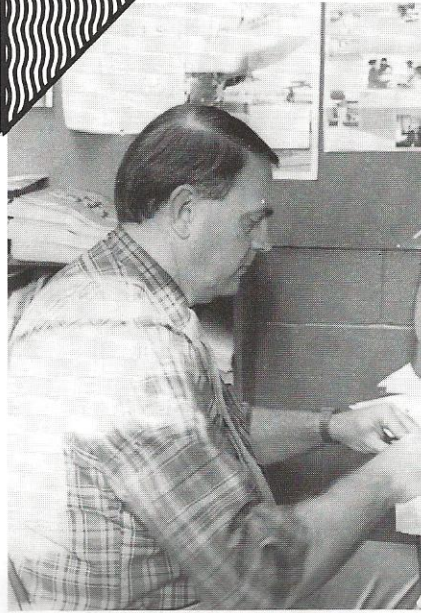


# Expert Guides Help Students Reach Goals



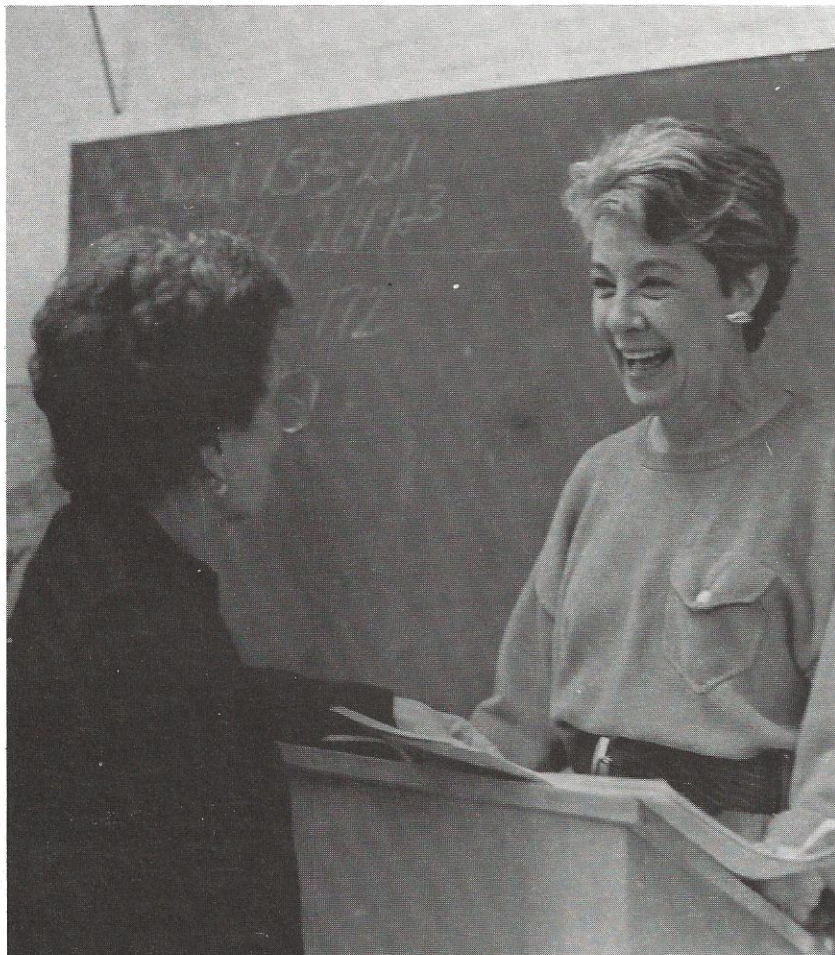
Mr. Jones, guidance counselor, works very hard on getting college registrations in order.
