

Dedicated With Much Appreciation

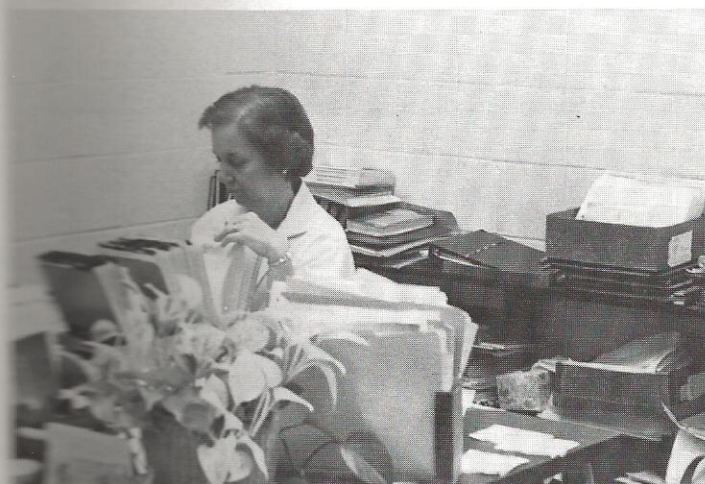
