



Spirit And Sportsmanship

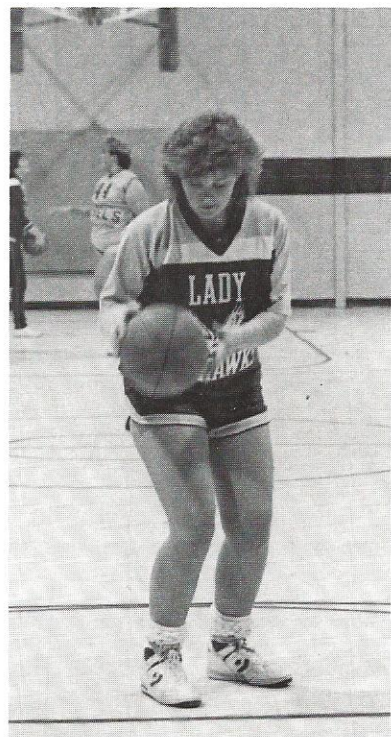
Showing True Blue Hawk Spirit, The Varsity Girls Always Held Their Heads High.
