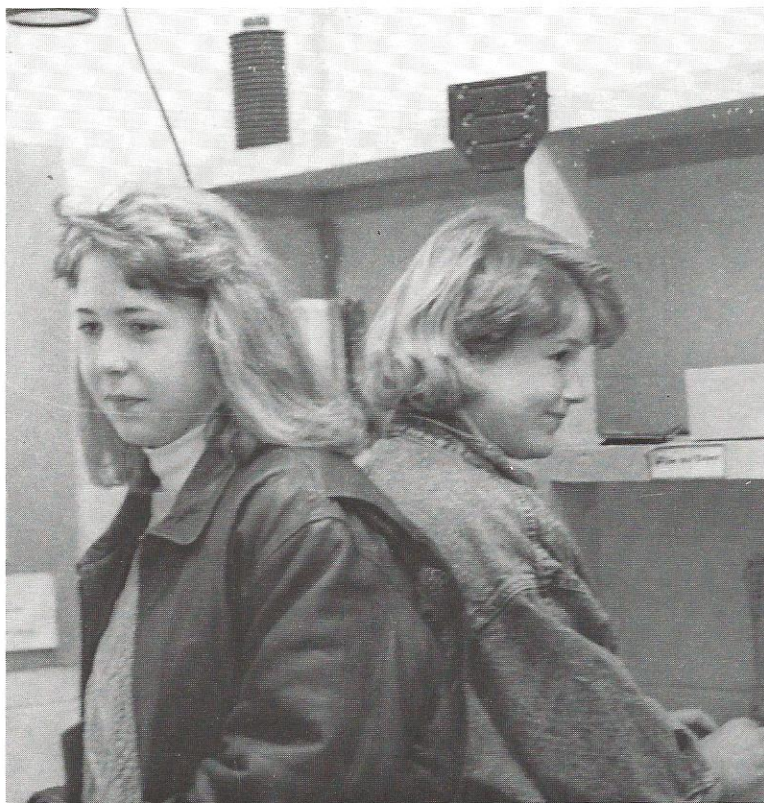


# NO PICTURES NO YEARBOOK, NO MEMORIES!
