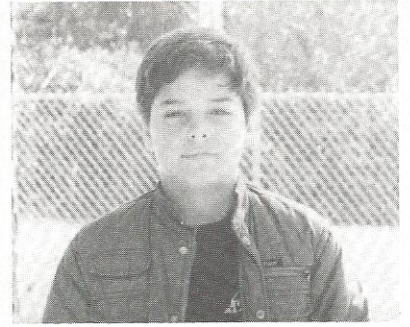

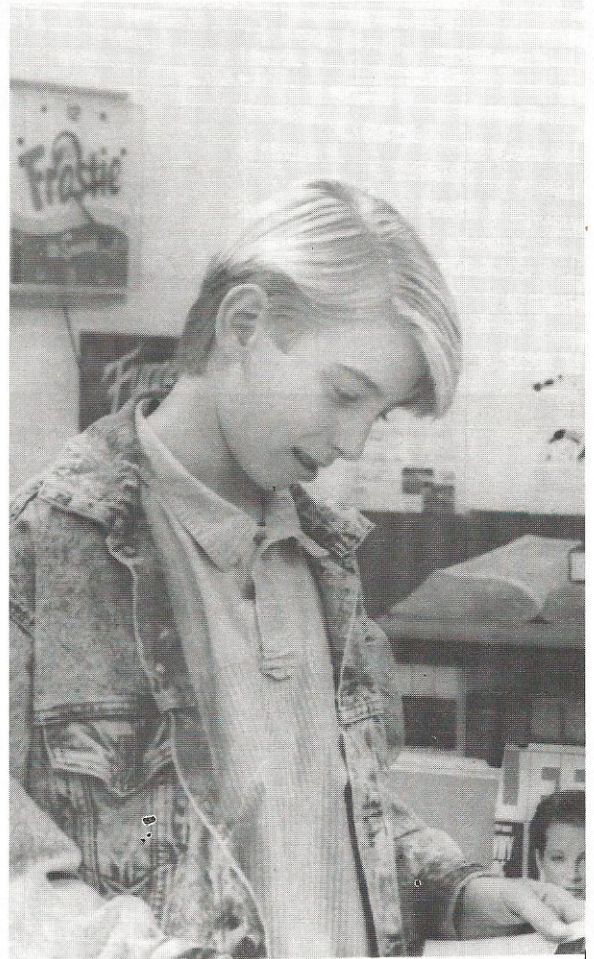
Perry Hunt recently was presented with a special award in Boy Scouting
