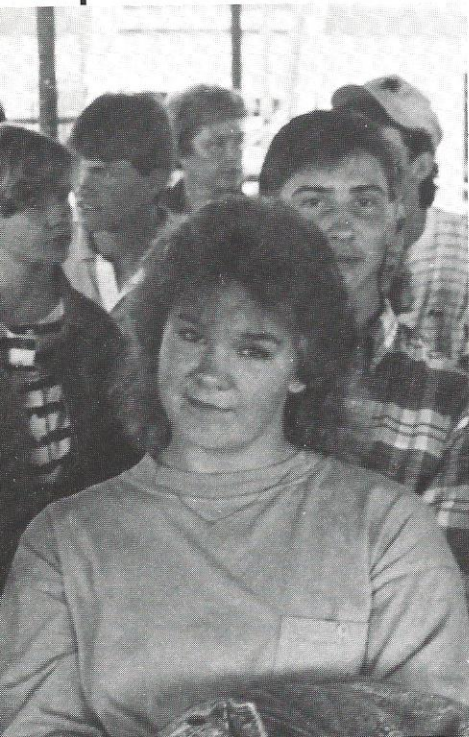


# MEMORIES NOT TO BE FORGOTTEN
