Apple released the **iPad** in April 2010, and sold 3 million of the devices in 80 days. According to a report released by Strategy Analytics, the Apple iPad had gained a 95 percent share of Tablet PC sales at the end of second quarter 2010. During the second quarter 2010, Apple had sold 4.19 million iPads around the world.





Atoms of **antimatter**, long the stuff of science fiction, have been trapped for the first time, European researchers at the Large Hadron Collider say. Scientists at the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) have trapped and held 38 anti-hydrogen atoms in place, each for a fraction of a second, the BBC reported. While anti-hydrogen has been produced before, it was instantly destroyed when it encountered normal matter. The CERN team, writing in the journal Nature, says the ability to study such antimatter atoms will allow previously impossible tests of fundamental laws of physics.



The **solar eclipse** of January 15, 2010 was an annular eclipse of the Sun with a magnitude of 0.9190. A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between Earth and the Sun, thereby totally or partially obscuring the image of the Sun for a viewer on Earth.

Chile earthquake in February was so powerful that it likely shifted an Earth axis and shortened the length of a day, NASA announced.
