











- 6. The United States defeated Japan 5-2 in the FIFA Women's World Cup held for the first time in Canada.
- **7**. **Joey Logano** won his first ever Daytona 500, beating out Kevin Harvick and Dale Earnhardt Jr.
- **8**. **Duke** won the NCAA Men's National Basketball Championship, defeating Wisconsin 68-63; this is the Blue Devil's 5th NCAA national title. Connecticut defeated Notre Dame 63-53 for their 3rd consecutive NCAA Women's National Basketball Championship.
- **9**. **Lydia Ko** won 5 tournaments and became the youngest winner of the LPGA Tour's Player of the Year award. Jason Day won his 1st PGA title with the lowest score in relation to par ever recorded in a major.
