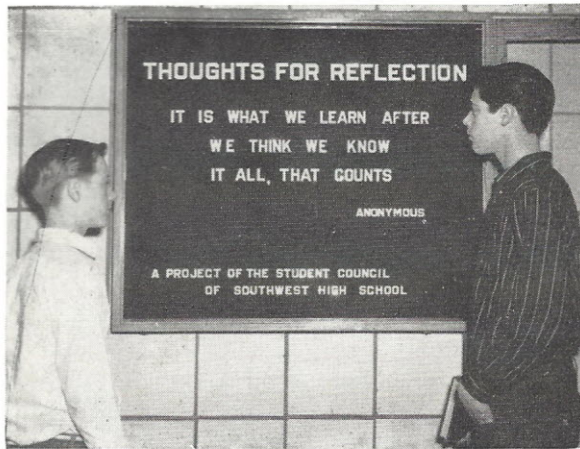


The Student Council
