Under the coaching of Mr. Ashley and the captaincy of Don Becherer, the 1957 Southwest golf squad finished with a .500 percentage, winning four matches and dropping an equal number. The turf toppers downed Beaumont and DeAndries twice, while losing to Kirkwood and Clayton once and Principia twice. Other lettermen besides Becherer were Dave Bartholic, Bill Beaty, and Gene Ziervogel. Southwest won the Public High League championship in 1955 but there has been no competition since then. Mr. Ashley explains it this way. "In the other P.H.L. schools, there seems to be a good number of boys who want to play but no one is willing to coach them. As a result, we have to seek out matches with county schools, who receive more school support and have better facilities." About future chances, the coach has this to say, "We should have a good season as all our lettermen are returning. But they will all graduate in June so I would like to see a large turnout next spring."
