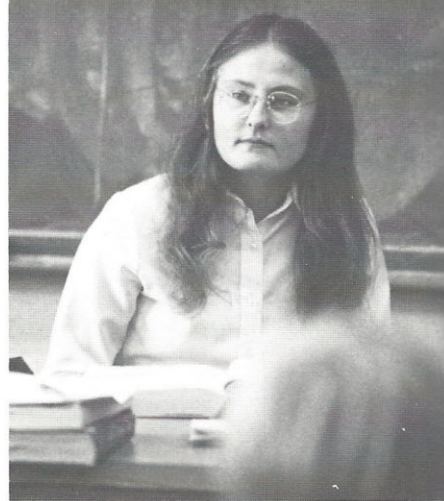
# Social Studies Broaden Knowledge of the World
