

# Enthusiasm Sparks 1980 Rebel Varsity Football Team

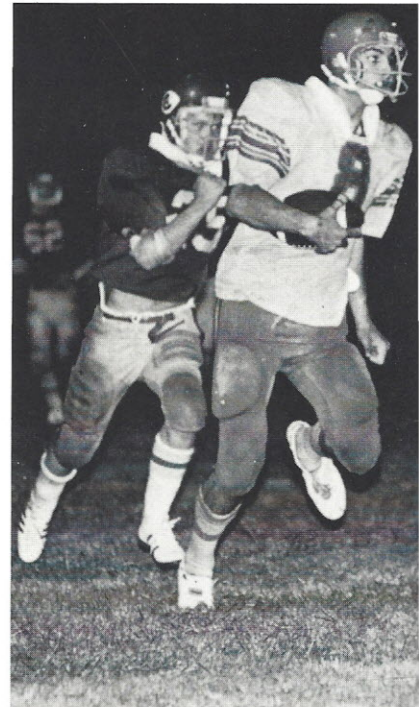
Summer football camp at Winthrop College was a new, but valuable experience for the 1980 varsity football team. Camp was an inspiration to coaches and players. New head coach
