
#### Languages





MRS. MERYL B. JONES is the head of our mathematics department. The department offers general mathematics, algebra, geometry, advanced algebra, and trigonometry.











# Commercial and Vocational

MR. H. E. CONE is the head of the commercial department. The department offers courses in typing, shorthand, bookkeeping, notehand, business math, and distributive education. These subjects prepare the students for immediate employment as well as for futher education.

The vocational department is divided into three parts: agricultural, headed by MR. S. M. PADGETT; home economics, headed by MRS. FRIEDA BLACK; and trade and industrial, headed by MR. H. E. MINES. The department offers agriculture, home economics, mechanical drawing, shop, wood, auto mechanics, plumbing, and diversified occupations. Students taking these subjects are given actual practice and instruction in each of these subjects.


