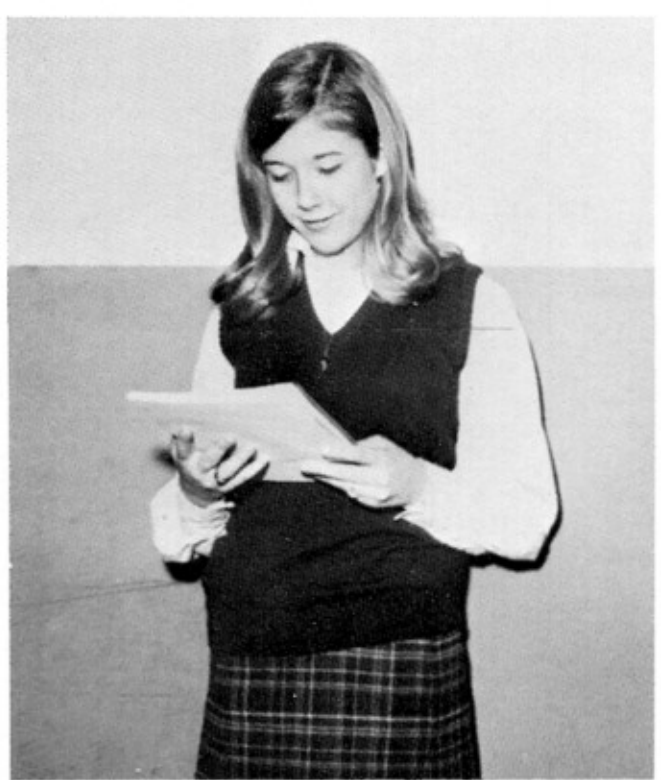


The Wildcat Staff Deserves Pulitzer Prize
